VILLAGE OF PERTH-ANDOVER ANNUAL NOTICE OF OUR EVACUATION POLICY

In the event of any type of disaster in our Community, the following actions will be taken to evacuate the affected area. Please retain this sheet for reference.

1. **Five minute sounding of the fire siren** will be the notification to alert residents that evacuation is ordered.
2. **Door to door visits by police** and other emergency personnel with instructions for those in low areas who must be evacuated and to confirm that all have received notification.
3. ***Once ordered to evacuate, you must do so*** security will be maintained by the RCMP. The RCMP will strictly control traffic and entry back into the Village in the event of evacuations.
4. **Before you leave you house, place your placard in a prominent location**, visible from street, so that emergency personnel know you have left.
5. **Report to the nearest reception center to register you and your family:**

Tourist Center 273-6740
Registration will enable officials to account for your safety and to respond to enquiries from concerned friends and relatives. Officials can assist with emergency food and lodging, emergency clothing, personal services, and emotional support.
6. **Take essential with you** - such as clothing, prescribed medications, personal toiletries, significant children's items, and identification.
